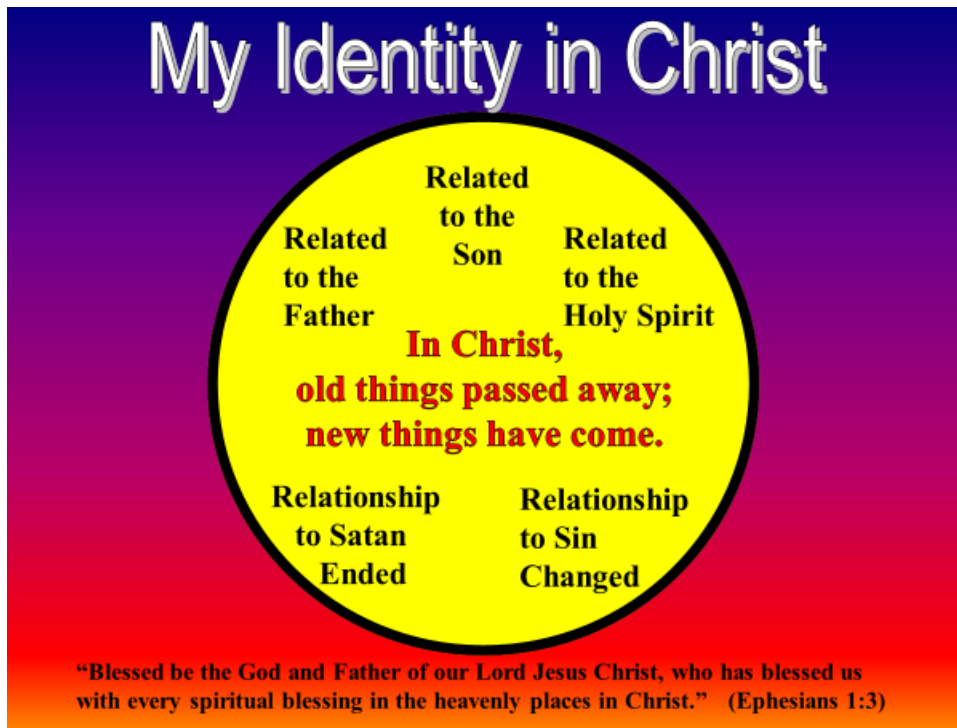
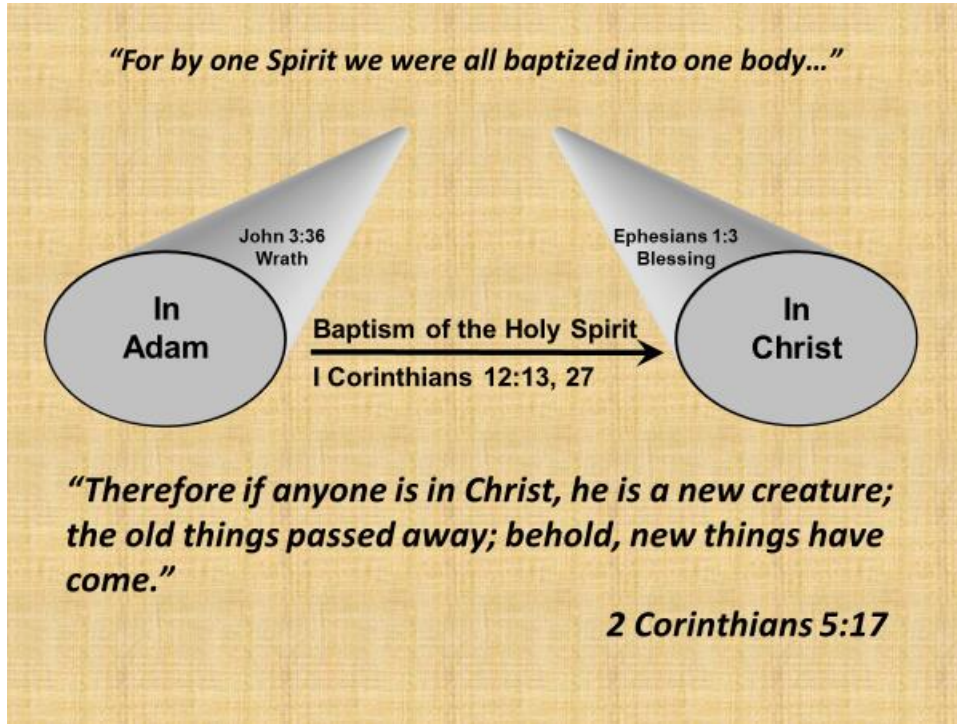

Relationship to Sin Changed

1. Redeemed

Ephesians 1:7 "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace,"

Colossians 1:14 "in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins."

Romans 3:24 "being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;"

2. Forgiven

Ephesians 1:7 "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace,"

Colossians 1:14 "in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins."

- *No condemnation*

Romans 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

3. Justified

II Corinthians 5:21 "He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."

Romans 3:24 "being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;"

I Corinthians 1:30 "But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption,"

- **Qualified**

Colossians 1:12 "giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light"

- **Perfected**

Hebrews 10:14 "For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified."

Colossians 1:28 "And we proclaim Him, admonishing every man and teaching every man with all wisdom, that we may present every man complete in Christ."

- **Glorified**

Romans 8:30 "and whom He predestined, these He also called; and whom he called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified."

4. Dead to the Old Nature

Romans 6:6, 11 "knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, that our body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin;"

"Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus."

- **Circumcised in Christ**

Colossians 2:11 "and in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ,"

Philippians 3:3 "for we are the true circumcision, who worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh,"

Relationship to Satan Ended

1. Delivered from the domain of darkness.

Colossians 1:13 "For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,"

Acts 26:18 "...open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God,"

- **Light in the Lord**

Ephesians 5:8 "for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light"

I Thessalonians 5:4-5 "But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that the day should overtake you like a thief; for you are all sons of light and sons of day. We are not of night or darkness;"

2. Transferred into the kingdom of His Son.

Colossians 1:13 "For He delivered us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,"

- **Citizenship in the heavenlies**

Philippians 3:20 "For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ;"

Ephesians 2:19 "So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God's household,"

- **Seated in the heavenlies**

Ephesians 2:4-6 "But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up in Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places, in Christ Jesus,"

Colossians 3:1-2 "If then you have been raised with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth."

Related to the Father

1. **United to the Father**

Ephesians 4:6 “one God and Father of all who is over all and through all and in all.”
I Thessalonians 1:1 “to the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:”

2. **Reconciled**

Colossians 1:20-22 “And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds, yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach—”

II Corinthians 5:18-20 “Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ,”

Romans 5:10-11 For if while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.”

- **Peace with God**

Romans 5:1 “Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,”

- **Made near**

Ephesians 2:13 “But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ”

- **Access**

Ephesians 2:18 “for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father.”

Ephesians 3:12 “in whom we have boldness and confident access through faith in Him.”

3. **Part of the Family**

Ephesians 2:19 “So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God’s household,”

Galatians 6:10 “let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.”

- **Child of God**

John 1:12 “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name,” Also see I John 3:1-2.

- **Adopted**

Ephesians 1:5 “He predestined us to adoption as sons through Christ to Himself.”

Galatians 4:5 “in order that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.”

- **Sonship**

Galatians 3:26 “For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.”

4. **God’s possession**

I Peter 2:9 “But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God’s own possession,”

Titus 2:14 “who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.”

Ephesians 1:14 “who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God’s own possession, to the praise of His glory.”

- **God’s inheritance**

Ephesians 1:18 “that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,”

Related to the Son

1. A gift to the Son

John 10:29 "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all,"
Also John 17:2, 6, 9, 24

2. United to the Son

John 14:18-20 "In that day you shall know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you."

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me."

Colossians 1:27 "...Christ in you, the hope of glory."

3. Identified with His work:

• Crucified with Christ

Romans 6:6 "knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, that our body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin;"

Galatians 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me."

• Dead with Christ

Romans 6:8 "Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,"

Colossians 3:3 "For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God."
Also Colossians 2:20

• Buried with Christ

Romans 6:4 "Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, in order that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life."

• Raised with Christ

Colossians 3:1 "if then you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God."

4. On a secure foundation

I Corinthians 3:11 "For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ."

5. Complete in Him

Colossians 2:10 "and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority,"

Related to the Holy Spirit

1. United to the Holy Spirit (Indwelling)

Romans 8:9 “However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.”

Titus 3:6 the Holy Spirit, “whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,”

I Corinthians 6:19 “Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?”

2. Regenerated by the Holy Spirit

Titus 3:5 “He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to his mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,”

John 3:6, 8 “That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.”

3. Baptized by the Holy Spirit

I Corinthians 12:13 “For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.”

Galatians 3:27 “For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.”

4. Sealed by the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 4:30 “And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.”

Ephesians 1:13-14 “In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God’s own possession, to the praise of His glory.”

II Corinthians 1:21-22 “Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God, who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.”

New Standing in Christ

1. **Eternal Life**

John 3:15 "that whoever believes may in Him have eternal life."

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

I Corinthians 15:2 2 "For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all shall be made alive."

II Timothy 1:1 "life in Christ Jesus"

II Timothy 2:10 "For this reason I endure all things for the sake of those who were chosen, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus and with it eternal glory."

- **Heirs**

Romans 8:17 "and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ,"

- **Inheritance**

Colossians 3:24 "knowing from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance."

Ephesians 1:13-14 "In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory."

I Peter 1:4-5 "to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, who are protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time."

2. **Holy / Sanctified**

I Corinthians 1:2 "those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, saints by calling,"

I Corinthians 1:30 "But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption,"

Acts 26:18 "In order that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me."

Hebrews 10:10 "By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

- **Priesthood**

I Peter 2:5, 9 "you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood," "you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood,"

Revelation 1:6 "and He has made us to be a kingdom, priests to His God and Father;"

3. **Under Grace**

Romans 6:14 "For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law, but under grace."

Ephesians 1:6 "to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved."

Ephesians 2:7 "in order that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus."

I Corinthians 1:4 "I thank my God always concerning you, for the grace of God which was given you in Christ Jesus."

- **Free from Law**

Romans 6:14 "For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law, but under grace."

Romans 7:4,6 "you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, that we might bear fruit for God."

"But now we have been released from the Law, having died to that by which we were bound, so that we serve in newness of the Spirit and not in oldness of the letter."

- **In the Love of God**

Romans 8:38-39 "For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

I Timothy 1:14 "and the grace of our Lord was more abundant, with the faith and love which are found in Christ Jesus."

II Timothy 1:13 "Retain the standard of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus."

4. A New Creation

II Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away behold, new things have come."

Ephesians 2:10 "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."
